This platform celebrates creativity, artistry, and the limitless potential of the performing arts. Prepare to be amazed by exceptional talent and innovation in nukkad natak, drama at YUGANTAR.

YUGANTAR is an open-stage competition featuring:

1. Nukkad Natak
2. Drama

Rules & Regulations:

Participants must register in advance and adhere to the instructions provided by the organizers.

Participants should respect the time limits and any competition etiquette.

Original work is encouraged, and proper credit must be given if using existing material.

Content must avoid offensive, vulgar, or inappropriate themes that could harm or offend others.

Participants should be ready to accept judges' feedback and results with grace.

Accommodation & Travel:

Free accommodation will be provided for all participants and one supervising professor or student in-charge.

Travel expenses will be reimbursed up to ₹1,000 per participant and ₹2,000 for professors/students in-charge, upon submission of receipts.

Competition Rounds:

A. Round 1: Preliminary Round [Online Elimination]

Participants must submit a video featuring a Drama or Nukkad Natak on a topic of their choice.

Video submissions are limited to 10 minutes.

Registered teams must upload their videos using the link provided once the round starts.

Performances can be conducted in either Hindi or English.

Participants may use an original script or adapt an existing one, with original works scoring higher.

File names should follow this format: TeamName_CollegeName_EventName.

Videos must be uploaded to a Google Drive folder, and links shared via Google Form, ensuring access is set to "Anyone with Link."

B. Round 2: Final Round [Offline - On Campus]

Performances in Hindi and English are permitted for Drama or Nukkad Natak. The time limit is 15 minutes, with penalties for exceeding this limit.

Inappropriate language may lead to disqualification.

Judges' decisions are final and must be respected.

Performances should stay within designated areas.

The use of dangerous props or elements is prohibited.

No technical support (like background music, costumes, or props) will be provided by the host institution.

Teams may use banners and posters.

Instruments like the dholak or flute are allowed.

Microphones, lights, or electronic devices are not permitted.

Guidelines:

Participation is open to all undergraduate and postgraduate students enrolled in recognized universities.

Participants may compete individually or as part of a team.

All members of a team must be students of the same university.

Multiple teams from a single institution are permitted to participate.

The composition of teams shall remain unchanged after registration.

Each participant is required to carry a valid identification document for verification purposes.

On-site registrations will be accepted subject to availability and event schedule.

Participants may choose to perform in Nukkad Natak or Drama as per their preference.

The use of offensive, abusive, or inappropriate language during performances is strictly prohibited. Any violation will result in immediate disqualification.

Plagiarism in any form will not be tolerated. Participants must duly acknowledge and credit all sources or references used.

Participants are advised to thoroughly acquaint themselves with all event rules and guidelines prior to participation.

Any requirements related to props, music, or technical arrangements must be communicated and confirmed during the pre-registration process with the event coordinator.

All events shall commence as per the scheduled time, and participants are expected to maintain punctuality.

The organizing committee reserves the right to modify, amend, or interpret the rules as deemed necessary.

The decision of the organizers shall be final and binding on all participants.
